## Publications Database

**T**he NCSU Libraries has created a publications database that provides citations to more than 3,000 publications produced by faculty, staff, and students at NC State University since 1997. It is compiled and maintained by the Libraries' Cataloging Department, to whom additions and corrections may be addressed by using the form "Notify us of your publications" provided with the database on the library's Web site at URL: [www.lib.ncsu.edu/libraries/cataloging/NCSUPubs/](http://www.lib.ncsu.edu/libraries/cataloging/NCSUPubs/)

A fuller description of the project also is available at the Web site by selecting the "About the NC State community publications database" link at the top left of the screen.

The current version is made up of "static" HTML pages organized by year, author, department or agency, and journal title. It is updated monthly. Long-term plans are to create a keyword-searchable, live database. Citations include the author's primary affiliation and departmental status (e.g., faculty member, doctoral student, research staff), the location and call number for books and journals held by the NCSU Libraries, and links to Internet-accessible publications. Authors who hold cross-appointments in more than one department or program, as well as co-authors of single works, have been accommodated using the relational capabilities of the database.
