Plant Management Network Now Available

The Plant Management Network (PMN) is a multidisciplinary Internet resource specializing in applied plant science and agricultural information and communication. It is a collaboration of scientific societies, academic institutions, industry, and government agencies. Since the College of Agriculture and Life Sciences is a participating partner in the PMN, all NC State faculty, students, and staff receive unlimited access to the network's online subscription content. This resource should be of interest to anyone involved in applied plant science research, extension, and teaching.

The PMN provides access to two peer-reviewed electronic-only journals, *Plant Health Progress* and *Crop Management*. *Plant Health Progress* covers all aspects of applied plant health management while *Crop Management* focuses on applied crop science. Some benefits to authors who publish in these journals are no page charges; free use of color; publication within one to three weeks of acceptance; initial posting in public areas of the journals; linkable literature citations; and free .pdf files of completed articles for use in filling reprint re-

quests, posting on the author's personal Web site, and for including in promotion and performance review packets.

The PMN also contains a searchable database of plant science materials housed elsewhere on the Web and an image database of more than 1,400 photographs. Partner institutions have provided the content.

The network can be accessed through the NCSU Libraries' catalog or Database Finder or by free personal subscription. Personal subscriptions provide additional benefits, such as access to all PMN subscription content by individual user name and password; the right to copy and distribute PMN subscription content for use in the subscriber's own noncommercial work, teaching, and presentations; automatic electronic-mail alerts of new articles; personalized PMN services as they become available; and discounted registration fees for future PMN online events. Personal subscriptions can be set up by going to www.plantmanagementnetwork.org/partners/compsub/ncsu.asp and clicking on "enroll here." Subscribers then use their NCSU electronic-mail addresses to complete the enrollment process. ♦

NC LIVE Database Addition

The database resources offered by **NC LIVE** and available to all NC State library users has expanded with the addition of "Twentieth-Century English Poetry." This new online reference database was purchased with funds from the federal Library Services and Technology Act (LSTA), made possible through a grant from the Institute of Museum and Library Services administered by the State Library of North Carolina, a division of the Department of Cultural Resources.

The database provides an overview of poetry written in the twentieth century by established and emerging writers and incorporates the "Modern Poetry Collection" and "The Faber Poetry Library." The database contains more than 44,000 poems by 288 poets and features many canonical poets as well as those from diverse international backgrounds. Access to this resource is through the "Subject" or "Alphabetic" listings or from the list of vendors on the "Other" page under "Chadwyck-Healey." ♦
