## TRLN Joins Portico

**T**he NCSU Libraries together with its Triangle Research Libraries Network (TRLN), has joined **Portico**, a national member-supported, electronic-archiving service. Already a member of the Lots of Copies Keeps Stuff Safe (LOCKSS) Alliance, the NCSU Libraries has joined Portico to signal its growing support of national collaborative electronic-archiving efforts and the long-term preservation of electronic journals for use by students and faculty. Portico is a permanent electronic-archiving service for electronic journals that collects electronic files directly from publishers and makes them available to participating libraries should the publisher no longer be able to provide access. Launched in 2004 as open-source software, LOCKSS allows libraries, with the assent of participating publishers, to collect, store, preserve, and provide access to their own, local copy of authorized content they purchase.

These efforts, which have been historically supported by NCSU Libraries, are critical to faculty and student research. In addition to helping scholars manage copyright issues and craft alternatives to high-priced forms of scholarly publishing, the NCSU Libraries is able to establish trusted archives in which the published scholarly record in electronic form can persist outside of the exclusive control of publishers and in the control of libraries that value long-term accessibility. ♦

**T**he NCSU Libraries is pleased to announce online access to the *Chronicle of Higher Education Campuswide*—the number one news and job-information source for college and university faculty members, administrators, and staff. The full content of each issue is now available to the NCSU community every Monday morning, with daily, Web-only updates. Web access also includes searchable archives from September 1989 to the present, annual *Almanac of Higher Education* data, and more (see the publisher's full description at <http://chronicle.com/subscribe/campuswide/more.htm>).
