Howard Besser To Speak at 2002 I. T. Littleton Seminar

Howard Besser, associate professor at UCLA's School of Education and Information Studies, will speak at the 2002 I. T. Littleton Seminar, which will be held on **April 2 at 2:30 P.M. in the Erdahl-Cloyd Theater, D. H. Hill Library**. A reception will follow. The seminar is free and open to the entire NC State community, the TRLN communities, and library colleagues from North Carolina.

Besser will discuss one of his major research topics, the social effects of information technologies. He has written extensively on the effects of information technologies on cultural heritage institutions, policies, and consumers. Besser also has research interests in digital libraries, multi-media databases, and in teaching with technology.
