The Libraries' Eve Mitt Wins a NASIG Student Grant

The NCSU Libraries' Eve Mitt, who works in the Cataloging Department, recently learned that she has received one of three generous grants given by the North American Serials Interest Group (NASIG) to students enrolled at the graduate level in library school. The grant covers all 2004 NASIG annual conference expenses—including travel, registration, meals, and lodging—and a full year's membership in NASIG.

NASIG's Nineteenth Annual Conference takes place this year in Milwaukee, Wisconsin, from June 17 through June 20. By awarding selected students

membership to NASIG as well as supporting their conference expenses, NASIG encourages these students to pursue aspects of serials work upon completion of their professional degrees.
