# IEEE/IEE Electronic Library

he D. H. Hill Library now has an IEEE/IEE Electronic Library (IEL) station in the reference area. The IEL provides full-page images in electronic format of publications of the Institute of Electrical and Electronics Engineers (IEEE) and the Institution of Electrical Engineers (IEE). The IEEE and the IEE are the premier societies for electrical engineering. Together, the institutions claim to publish 32 percent of the world's current literature in electrical engineering and computer science. The IEL at D. H. Hill joins an IEL that has been in the Textiles Library on Centennial Campus since December.

The IEL is updated with about 25,000 new pages per month and includes a backfile of all IEEE and IEE publications published since January 1988, including journals, conference proceedings, and IEEE industry standards (IEEE and IEE monographs are not included in

the IEL). It consists of a high-speed computer, laser printer, and 372 CD-ROMs in sixty-two cartridges.

While the Libraries subscribes to print versions of all the journals and most of the conference proceedings, library users will like the convenience of finding them all in a single location on the IEL. The print journals will still be more up-to-date by one or two months, but the library now has digital back-up for those sent to the bindery.
