Tripsaver Expands Services

Tripsaver, the NCSU Libraries' interlibrary and information delivery service, has long provided books, articles, and other library materials not available in the Libraries' collections to the university community. These materials are typically obtained from other research libraries, often in the Triangle, and other document services. Tripsaver also provides materials from the NCSU Libraries' collections to distance learners and facilitates book and article delivery between the main and branch libraries and from the Satellite Shelving Facility.

Beginning this semester, Tripsaver is offering Web delivery of articles, book chapters, and other materials from the Libraries' print and microform collections to NCSU students, faculty, staff, and affiliates. The fee for this service is \$8.00 for

articles up to thirty pages in length. Items are delivered as .pdf files via the Web to the desktop. Fax or campus mail delivery of items is also available. For ordering information and payment options, go to: <http://www.lib.ncsu.edu/tripsaver/DocumentDelivery.html>.

In addition, the new NCSU Libraries Delivery Service is available to individuals, companies, and other organizations outside of the university. It offers delivery of articles, parts of books, and other documents from the Libraries' collections for a fee of \$12 (up to thirty pages).
