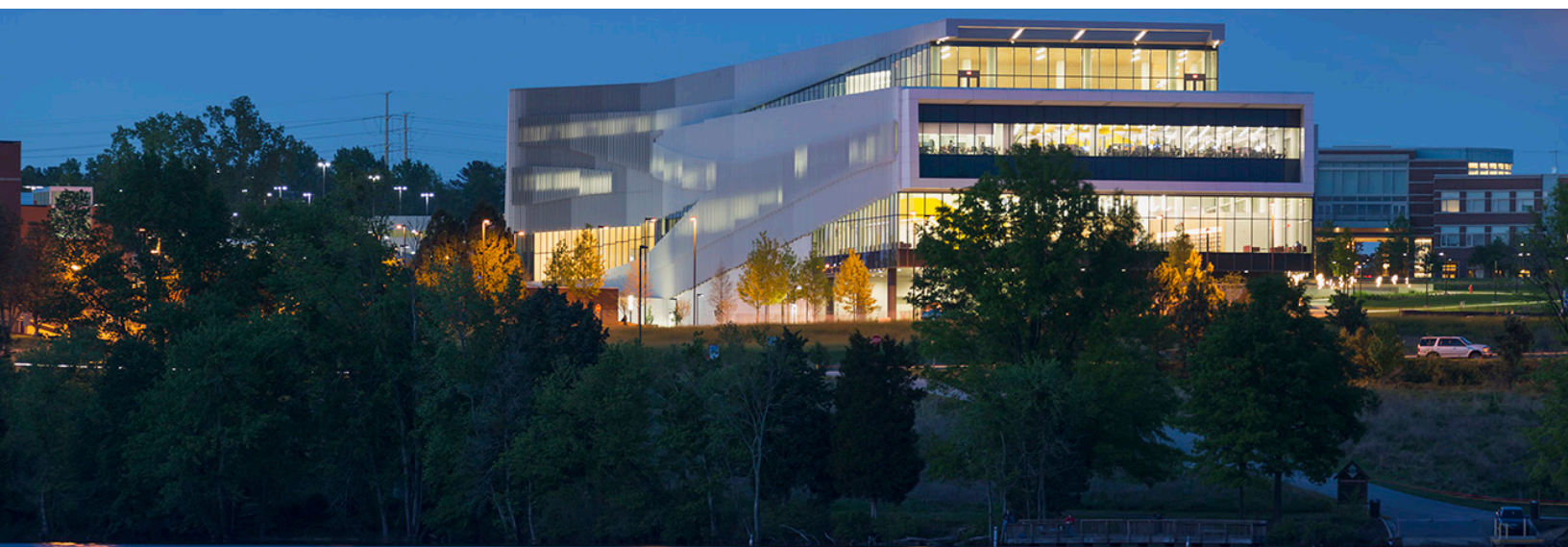
NC STATE'S COMPETITIVE EDGE
