The seventh floor of the Hill Library Bookstacks contains various seating options for individuals or groups, and group study rooms in the South Tower.

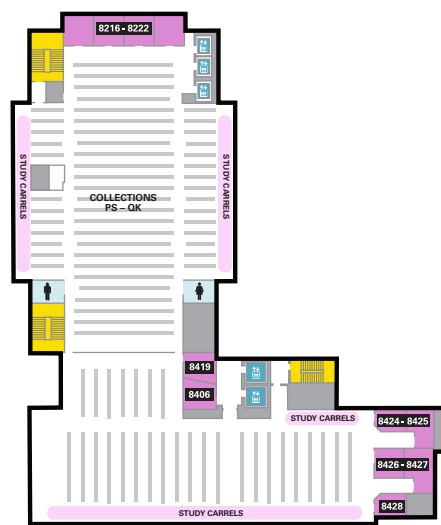
- **M-PR call numbers** start in the North Tower and continue into the South Tower.

Quiet Floors

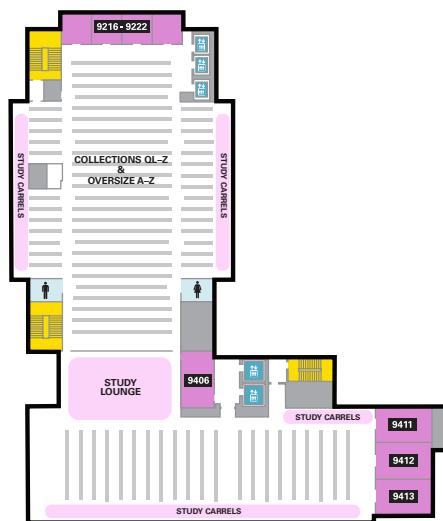
The eighth and ninth floors of the Hill Library Bookstacks are designated Quiet Floors. Hushed voices only please.

Ninth Floor

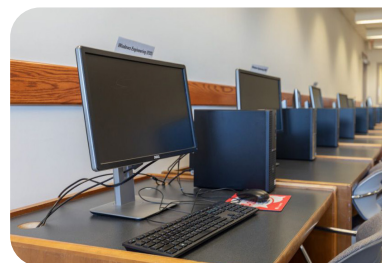
The ninth floor of the Hill Library Bookstacks contains various seating options for individuals, and group study rooms in the South Tower.

The EOS Lab has both Windows and Linux computers running the College of Engineering's image. The Linux computers are in the North Tower and the Windows computers are in the South Tower.



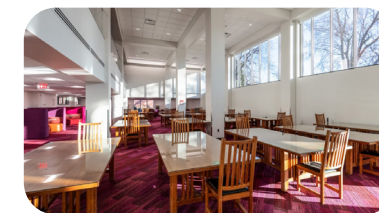
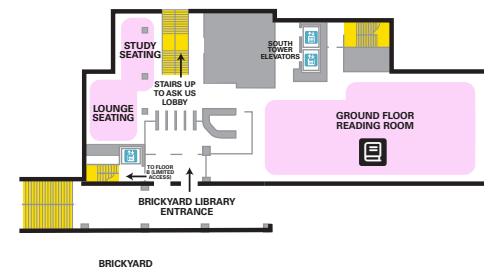

The SCRC includes the Special Collections Reading Room and the Exhibit Gallery. You can access the SCRC's materials at the Service Desk (request in advance).

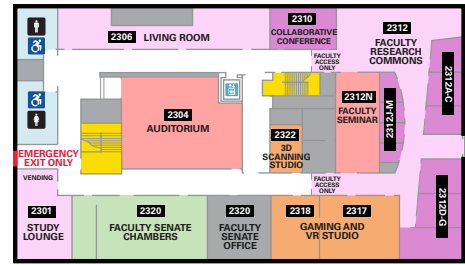

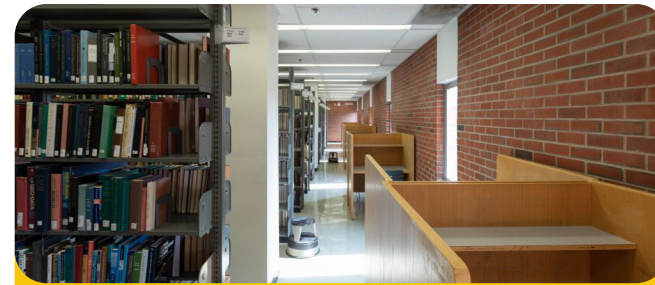


Data Experience Lab

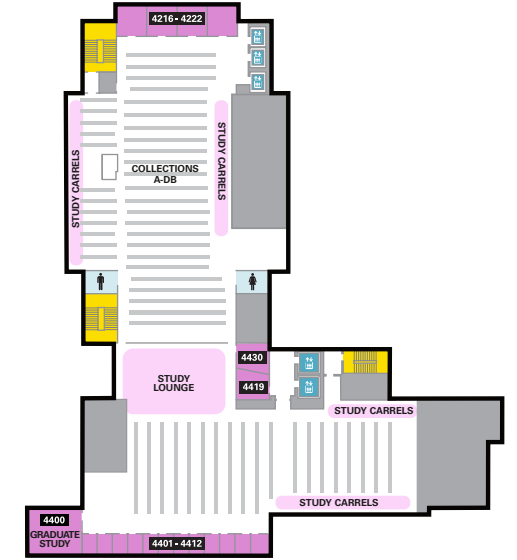

The fourth floor of the Hill Library Bookstacks contains a variety of seating options for individuals or groups.

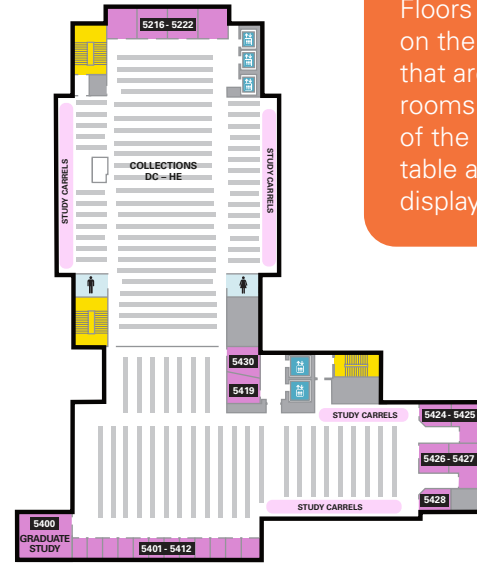
- **A-DB call numbers** start in the North Tower and continue into the South Tower.
